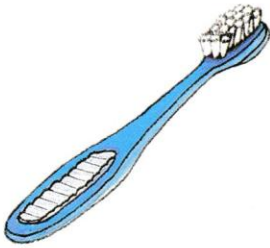

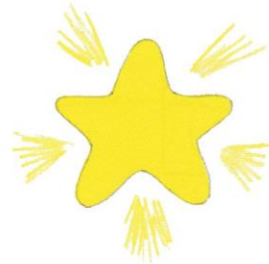
We can use a dictionary to check how to spell words.
