

Rock that is deep under the ground is very hot. Some rock gets so hot it melts. Sometimes, this melted rock comes up through the ground. When the rock pours out of the ground, it forms a volcano. The melted rock flows down the sides of the volcano. This melted rock is called lava. There can be hot ash too.

There are lots of volcanoes all over the world. A volcano has a **crater** (big hole) in its top. Some volcanoes have smoke coming out of the craters. Others have some ash and lava coming out, too.

Some of them are very quiet. There are no volcanoes today in Ireland.
