#### <u>SESE</u>

**Geography** – We have been working on a Mexico project recently. I have attached a postcard template below. Ask your child to complete the postcard as if they were writing it to someone in Mexico. They can share any facts they already know and encourage them to ask questions to the person when writing their postcard.

**History** – We have been learning about homes in the past, children have looked at examples of homes from the past and from today. The have compared the physical appearances of both. I have attached a worksheet below, the children will draw a home of the past and a home of today. They will then write a few sentences describing the differences.


