#### **Phonics**

• Introduce Magic e (also called silent e) and the letter o

#### <u>Magic e Rule</u>

"Magic e sits silently at the end of a word and scares the vowel and makes him say his name"

• Below are some examples of Magic e and o words. Have your child read these words and ask them what magic e does to the vowel if they become stuck. They are familiar with this as we have covered Magic e and the letters a/i in school.

# <u>Maths</u>

- Introduce simple vocabulary associated with time 'day', 'night', 'bright', 'dark'
- Associate different activities with 'day' and 'night'
- Game to teach the above One side of the room could be 'day' and the other could be 'night', the centre of the room could be either/both 'day and night'. Parent could call out different activities such as
  - 'brush your teeth' the child will go to the centre of the room as this is something you do both during the day and at night
  - 2. 'make your bed' the child goes to the 'day' side of the room
  - 3. 'close the curtains' the child goes to the 'night' side of the room etc.
- Watch Jack and Jill (Little Baby Bum) video on You Tube. Children are familiar with this video. Talk about the events of the story making use of vocabulary such as first, second, third, fourth, next, then, last.
- Complete the Jack and Jill Sequencing activity attached as separate PDF
- Look at and talk about the pictures on pg. 18 (Maths book). Try and put them in order of occurrence, again making use of the vocabulary above.
- Talk about the days of the week, the weekdays, the weekend, rhyme them off, today is \_\_\_\_\_, yesterday was \_\_\_\_\_, tomorrow will be \_\_\_\_\_ and associate activities with certain days e.g. go to school Monday through to Friday, do PE on Tuesday, do swimming on Thursday etc.

- Sequence the days of the week (cut and stick activity attached as separate PDF)
- Complete pg. 87 Days of the Week (Maths book)

## <u>SESE</u>

- We did a lot of work on recycling in school and had just introduced 'Energy'. Please enter the attached link into Google and read the story 'Guzzler's Big Book on Energy' to your child <u>https://www.seai.ie/community-energy/schools/schoolsdocuments/GUZZLER\_big\_bookENG\_LR.pdf</u>
- Discuss simple things you could do to help the environment/save energy using the story as a guide e.g. turn on lights when leaving the room, putting the plug in the sink while doing the dishes rather than letting hot water go down the drain.
- Identify appliances in the home that use electricity/energy and complete the attached activity sheet.
