<u>English</u>

- Recount writing- The children will work on writing a recount of their Christmas, the children are aware that they write in the past tense when completing recount writing. Encourage your child to write their recount in chronological order. Have your child complete the worksheet attached entitled "My Christmas holiday news" *upload to seesaw.
- Handwriting unfortunately the children were not able to bring their handwriting books home. I have scanned and attached the page they need. This week we will be working on the letter "n." Have your child trace the letters at the top of the page and complete the page (remind your child to use proper pencil grip). Encourage your child to work neatly and remind them to follow the directional arrows at the top of the page when forming the letters.
- Comprehension- Away With Words Pg 48 and 49- Bring and Show. Have your child read through the story and discuss it with them. Complete the activities on Pg 49. A and B (Remind your child use fall answers when answering the questions and not to start and answer with because). All children should write their answers in their homework copies.
- Plurals- This week we will be working on plurals. To introduce your child to this topic please go through the PowerPoint entitled "Plurals." Discuss and revise the rules with your child. Complete Away With Words Pg 40. Children on book rental can do this page in their homework copy.

**note that I have assigned an additional task to complete on seesaw entitled "Plurals S and ies" Please complete this task and submit it on seesaw.

• Phonics work- this week we will be working on phonics using the Sounds like Phonics programme linked on the schools learning assessments page (<u>https://slp.cjfallon.ie/</u>) click on the link and click into Sounds like Phonics book C. Click into Unit 2 The Doctors Surgery. Then click on the /oo/ oo sound. Complete the activities for this sound. Complete

Away With words Pg 21 (ee and oo). Children on book rental can write answers in their homework copy.

<u>Maths</u>

This week in maths we would be starting the topic of 3D shape. To introduce this topic please go through the PowerPoint "3D shapes" with your child and discuss (remember to use the correct vocabulary when discussing the shapes- vertices, edge and face. Watch this video with your child <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=AsQ_uJDBrIU</u> and revise the 3D shapes that are listed.

Mathemagic – Pg 95 and 96 Figure it out- Pg 50 *upload to seesaw.

I have uploaded additional tasks on seesaw called "3D shape sort" and "classify and sort 3D shapes" complete these tasks and submit on seesaw.

Additional activity – shape hunt around the home. Have your child look for these shapes around the home (sphere, cube, cuboid, cone, cylinder). Have them list as many things that they can find in the home for each shape.

Problem solving – I have uploaded a series of problem-solving questions and activities to seesaw, have your child work through these answer them. The children have learned to use the RUDE method of problem solving, encourage your child to use this when they are completing the problems

- R- Read
- U- Underline
- D- Draw
- E- Estimate

- Click Ceacht (lesson 1)-
- Click the speech bubble and listen to the Comhrá (conversation) for the lesson.

- Click on the games controller and have your child complete the online games and activities for the lesson – Cluiche Kin, Tasc Eisteachta, Bi ag Léamh and Líon na Bearnaí.
- Complete Pg 43 in Bua na Cainte (seesaw video uploaded- there is a video of me explaining this page on seesaw please have your child follow along) *upload to seesaw.

- Click the speech bubble and listen to the comhrá (conversation) for the lesson
- Click on the game controller and complete the activities Cuir na pictiúr in ord and líon na Bearnaí
- Complete Pg 44, for the children on book rental I have attached this page.
- Am don leamh 2 Pg 22 and 23 (I have uploaded a video of me reading through this and explaining it, please have your child follow along and complete the Pgs)

<u>SESE</u>

Geography – This week we are learning about streams, rivers, and seas. Engage your child in a discussion and ask them to name as many rivers, streams, and seas as they know. Ask your child if they know the difference between a river, stream, and sea. Read Pg 34 in What a Wonderful World and discuss this with your child. Read and complete Pg 35 with your child. Complete the river comprehension activity sheet attached.

History – This week we are learning an Irish myth "The salmon of knowledge." Read the story in What a Wonderful World Pg 36 and 37 (I have uploaded a video of me reading the

story to seesaw please have your child follow along). Discuss the story with your child and question them on it. Complete the wordsearch on Pg 37. Complete Fionn and the Salmon of Knowledge literacy activity (attached) have your child unscramble the sentences and rewrite them correctly. *upload to seesaw.

Science- This week we are learning about materials and their properties. Engage your child in a discussion about different materials and ask them to describe them to you. The children have already covered terms such as opaque, translucent and transparent and they should be able to use these when describing materials. Have your child name as many different materials as the can i.e. wood, plastic, glass etc. Go through the PowerPoint "materials" with your child and discuss. Complete Pg 31 in What a Wonderful World.

Additional activity – find 3 items made from each of these materials in your home – wood, glass, plastic and paper). Explain why each object is made from that specific material- you can can record this activity and post it to seesaw.

<u>Art</u>

The children will be learning about Picasso this week. Watch this video with your child to learn more about Picasso <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OAWpSKkFZ8U</u>

Your child will then create their own Picasso face. They will follow the example given at the end of the video and create their own Picasso face using old magazines or scrap materials. Your child can upload their finished art piece to seesaw.

Additional activities

These are some suggested activities/resources if your child would like some additional activities to complete.

- Children could complete a book review for their favourite book, templates can be found on Twinkl
- Additional maths activities-children can also complete any worksheets/ activities from Twinkl which are revision of topics already covered including addition, subtraction, money, 2D/3D shapes, data and place value
- Children can go back through the previously completed weeks in their Spellbound and revise their spellings. You could also choose any of these words and ask your child to put them into sentences. Look out for any words that your child is spelling incorrectly and revise these words in particular.
- Storyline Online is a great free resource that the children are already familiar with, there is a verity of different stories which they children can listen to and each story is accompanied by activities and worksheets
- You may be aware that RTE will be broadcasting school on TV from 10-12 Monday to Friday on RTÉ 2. Your child may wish to watch and participate in these lessons.
