The children used junk art materials to create different types of homes

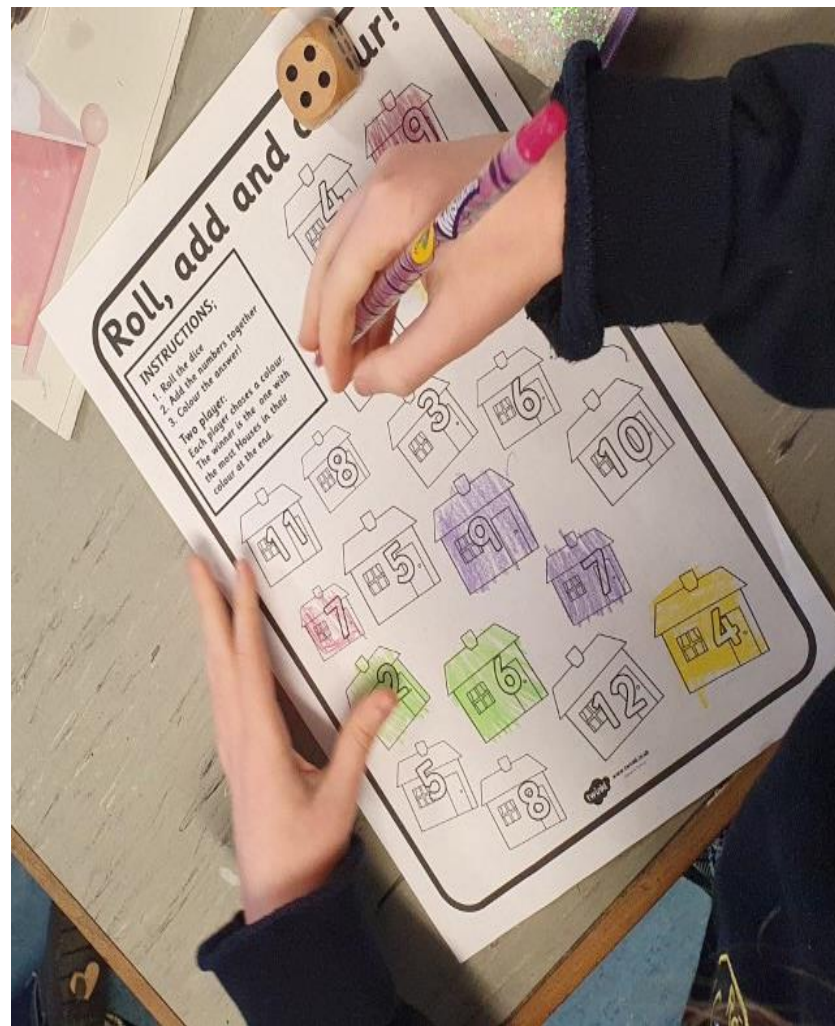

The children played Bingo and a Memory Game around the theme The Home







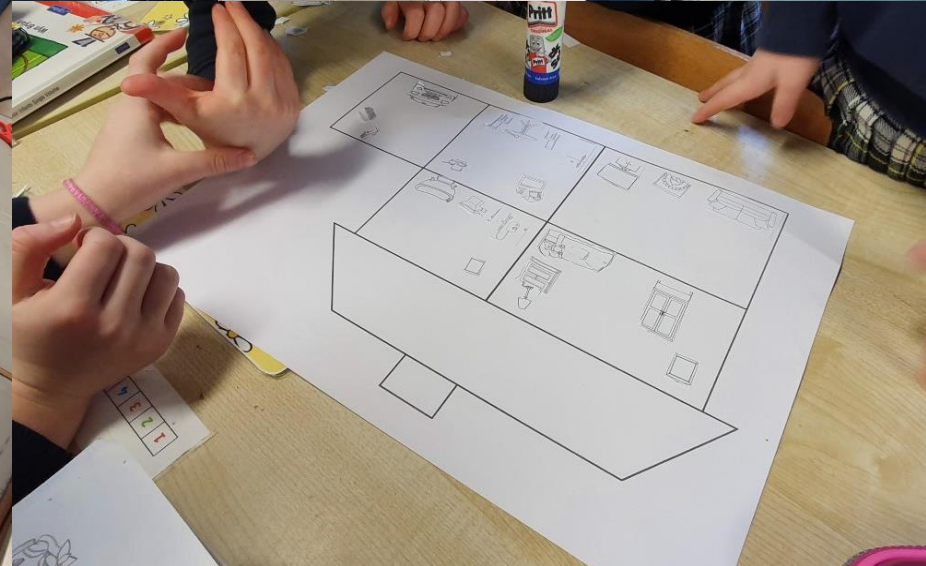
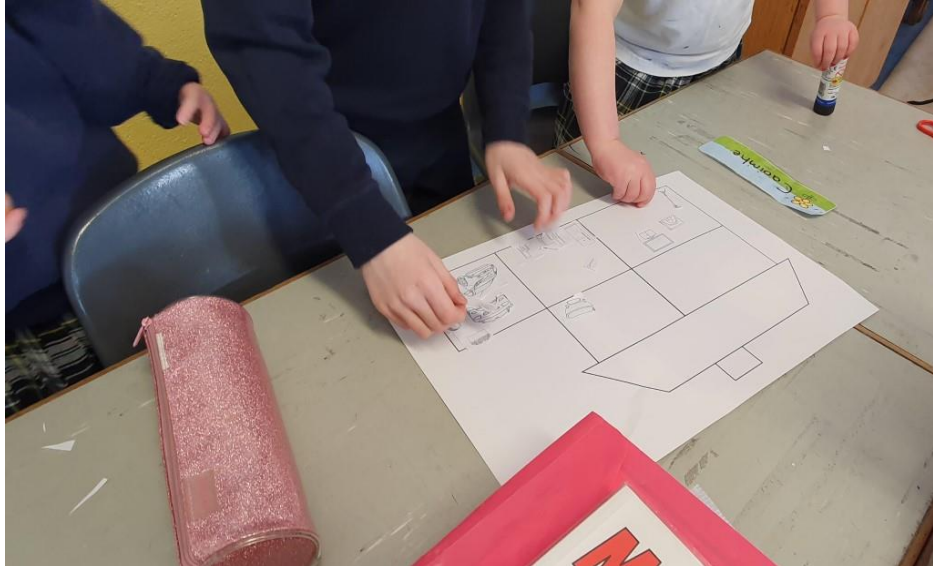
The Small World station was a definite favourite of all the children so each group had two opportunities to play at this station
